Gauteng Shipment

Here is an update from our tireless South African volunteers Lauren and Andrea:

Siyafunda Community Technology Centre - Guanteng

ABCA delivered books to *Siyafunda Community Technology Centre* in Katlehong last week (see photos attached).

Siyafunda have centres in rural communities in Limpopo, Mpumalanga, Eastern Cape and Gauteng. They teach computer skills, IT, and robotics to school kids and adults, and teach literacy skills to help kids who can't read. Siyafunda sent us a list of schools who would like to receive books in these rural areas. They will distribute the books for ABCA to these schools and communities and will send photos and thank-you letters.









Fingertips of Africa

Fingertips of Africa is a charity that runs feeding schemes and soup kitchens for those in need.
